## 142. MIGRANT STUDENTS

1. Authority SC 1326, 1327 20 U.S.C. Sec. 6391 et seq 34 CFR 200.81-200.88 The Joint Operating Committee establishes a program to address the needs and provide appropriate services to migrant students attending the center.

2. Guidelines

The center's program for migrant students shall include procedures to:

- 1. Identify migrant students and assess their educational and related health and social needs.
- 2. Ensure migrant students have the appropriate educational opportunities to meet the same academic standards required of all students.

- 3. Provide a full range of services to migrant students.
- 4. Provide parents/guardians an opportunity for meaningful participation in the program.
- 5. Provide advocacy and outreach programs for migrant students and their families.
- 6. Provide professional development for center staff.

The center shall provide materials to parents/guardians regarding their role in improving the academic achievement of their child.

3. Delegation of Responsibility

The Administrative Director or designee shall develop procedures to notify and involve parents/guardians in the development, implementation and evaluation of the center's program for migrant students.
