214. CLASS RANK	
<p>1. Authority SC 1850.1</p>	<p>The Joint Operating Committee authorizes a system of computing grade point averages and class rank for students to inform students, parents/guardians and institutions of a student's relative placement among their peers.</p>
<p>2. Guidelines</p>	<p>Class rank shall be computed by the final grade in all subjects for which credit is awarded.</p> <p>Any two (2) or more students whose computed grade point averages are identical shall be given the same rank. The rank of the student who immediately follows a tied position will be determined by the number of students preceding and not by the rank of the person preceding him/her.</p>
<p>Pol. 216</p>	<p>A student's grade point average and rank in class shall be entered on the student's record and transcripts and shall be subject to the Joint Operating Committee's policy on release of student records.</p>
<p>3. Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>The Administrative Director or designee shall develop procedures for computing grade point averages and assigning class rank to implement this policy, which shall include a statement of the methods for computation and rank assignment for those to whom a student's grade point average and class rank are released.</p>
