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		217. SKILLS CERTIFICATION
	1. Purpose	The Joint Operating Committee will acknowledge each student's successful completion of the vocational technical program by awarding a certificate at appropriate ceremonies.
	2. Authority SC 1613, 1850.1	The Joint Operating Committee shall issue a certificate to every student with a passing grade average after three (3) years of skilled training and/or a sufficient number of completed competencies. Students who do not meet the criteria may receive a certificate of participation.
	SC 1614 Title 22 Sec. 11.27 Pol. 113	The Joint Operating Committee shall permit a student with a disability, who has attended four (4) years of high school, to participate in ceremonies with his/her graduating class and receive a certificate of attendance, even if the student's Individualized Education Plan (IEP) prescribes continued educational services.
		The Joint Operating Committee shall provide documents by which a student may indicate to an employer or postsecondary institution the completion of a vocational technical program and attainment of skills.
	3. Delegation of Responsibility	The Administrative Director or designee shall be responsible for planning and executing ceremonies that appropriately recognize this important achievement.
