Ways to save money!

Be sure to search for ways to make this low-cost training even easier for you to achieve. The following are several considerations:

TUITION ASSISTANCE: Your company may be able to assist you. Please verify if your company has any education assistance programs and indicate if you or your company will be paying for tuition and / or books on your application form.

PAYMENT PLANS AVAILABLE: If you are paying part or all of the tuition for the Apprenticeship program, monthly payment plans paid via credit card are available upon request. These payment plans are made available to you interest-free. (Certain conditions apply.)

STATE AID: If you are laid off, unemployed or are earning less than \$11 per hour, be sure to stop by your local Pennsylvania CareerLink Office and ask them if they have any state-funded programs that could assist you with covering the cost of the tuition, such as Individual Training Account Funds (ITAs), OVR Funds and Veteran Assistance. Fund availability varies by county and may also be based on your individual financial circumstances.

Hands-on Training

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Years 1 and 2 classes will incorporate shop time into the theory lessons. Students will learn to use manual mills, lathes, drill presses, grinders, and more. Spots (15) are limited per class and subject to change.



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Application Details - PLEASE READ

- NEW for 2020 <u>TABE Tests</u> (Test of Adult Basic Education) for Year 1 apprentices are <u>NO LONGER required</u>. If a company requires this test for their program, please contact the NTMA staff.
- > Upon receipt of your application, we will send you a **confirmation letter** in the mail confirming your school location with start date/times for classes.
- If you marked on your application form that you are interested in taking <u>Advanced Placement Testing</u> you will receive a letter with details along with a sign-up form for the test. The test will be offered prior to the start of classes. You must complete the form and sign up in advance of the test. An invoice will be included with the sign-up form. Year 1 or 2: **Total Cost = \$100** (Math = \$50, Blue Print & TMT = \$50). There is NO advance placement testing for Year 3 or Year 4.
- It is important to <u>list your employer's contact person</u> on your application form. Please be sure to give us their name, phone number and <u>email.</u> We correspond with employers on a regular basis throughout the year and it is helpful to have this information.
- If you marked on your application form that you (the apprentice) are responsible for <u>tuition and/or book payment</u>, you will receive an appropriate invoice in the mail prior to the start of classes. Monthly payment plans are available for tuition. Please inquire. <u>Note: All books MUST be paid for PRIOR to the start of classes if being paid by you (the apprentice).</u>
 - If your company is responsible for payment, your company will receive an invoice directly.
- If you're interested in <u>purchasing books on your own</u>, contact the NTMA staff for book information. Otherwise, you will be supplied books on the first day of class.
- Please indicate your <u>First & Second</u> site choice where you would like to attend on the registration form. **NOTE: Due to enrollment constraints, your preferred site may not be available.**
- **Hands-on Training** is included for Years One and Two at all sites.
